

Notice of Public Information Hearing Regarding Proposed Ninth Biennial Revision to the Five-Year Plan for the Darlington Water Supply Service District

The purpose of this public information hearing is to solicit comments on the proposed ninth biennial update to the Five-Year Plan for the Darlington Water Supply Service District. MES is required by law to review and readopt the Five-Year Plan biennially after holding a public hearing. This ninth revised Five-Year Plan drafted by MES outlines planned capital improvements to the water supply system, anticipated sources of revenues for the improvements, and the financial status of the Service District.
