



Per comments from the County reviewing agencies during permitting processes, additional E&S and SWM work needed to be included in the engineering design and that increased the costs for construction. MES is currently working with the County DPW&T to increase the construction contract funds from \$450,000.00 to \$626,880.42 based on the bid result. Per County DPW&T's request, MES provided an updated construction cost projection on 12/2/21. The projection included the extra cost of the | |

construction contract as well as the costs for MES to provide fulltime inspection services (per DPW&T's recent request).

The upgrades will include the construction of a new equalization tank, expansion of the existing treatment building, process controls and upgrades to the electrical service and back-up generator. | Remarks: | The Contract provides for the purchase of Wood Chips for use as fuel to fire two wood fired boilers to produce steam to generate hot water and electricity for the Eastern Correctional Institution. On January 26, 2018, The Maryland Environmental Service entered into a contract with Eastern Shore Forest Products, (ESFP) to supply wood chips for 2 years at an estimated annual quantity of | |

60,000 tons per year. The contract allows for three (3) additional two (2) year terms. MES intends to exercise it second option to extend the contract for an additional two-year term (years 5-6). As required by contract MES requested pricing for the additional two-year term from the Contractor. On 12/3/2021 ESFP proposed a new rate of \$90.89 per ton. The contract value below reflects this value but is meant to be a NTE number. In its letter offering its proposed pricing, ESFP indicted that this price can be negotiated provided MES is willing to renegotiate specific contract terms related to non-performance penalties. MES is currently in negotiations with ESFP but we do not expect to conclude negotiations until sometime after January 01, 2022.
