Example of Job Duties

(Under the direction of a certified operator)

- Controls flow and adjusts treatment processes to ensure the facility achieves compliance with applicable environmental permits
- Monitors and documents facility performance
- Collects samples and conducts tests
- Performs operational control tests and process calculations
- Records test results, meter readings, gauge readings, flow quantities, and other technical data
- Performs maintenance according to the schedules and procedures of facilities
- Performs general housekeeping duties as needed or assigned
