Remarks: The Water Resources Registry (WRR) is a tool used by environmental professionals to identify sites for potential restoration and/or preservation from a cumulative impact perspective in order to cooperatively evaluate projects across various state and federal agencies. Each state participating in the WRR utilizes a registry for four main categories: wetlands, riparian areas, terrestrial areas, and stormwater management control. Maryland pioneered the WRR in 2006 to address cumulative impacts, and the registry has since grown to include seven other states and Puerto Rico. Consistent with the Agency's mission, MES' support on the WRR is funded through IntePros Federal Incorporated which receives funding from the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Water. MES provides technology support for software design, development, operations and maintenance, system architecture, help desk support and subject matter expertise for operation of the current WRRs as well as providing resources to those states interested in development of a registry.
