

OEM of the two 1.942 MW steam turbine generators (STG) at Eastern Correctional Institution (ECI). The OEM recommends having these critical spare turbine parts on hand during normal operations and prior to the overhaul of STG #2, which is currently planned for FY25.

The OEM-recommended spare parts included herein are fully inclusive of the turbine and trip-and-throttle (TTV) valve, except for the trip valve assembly. MES is currently evaluating replacing the 38-year-old, first-generation trip valve assembly with a newer generation safety

valve.

This is a new type of analysis, and only a few labs can handle the low PQL of 2 parts per trillion established by MDE. Per the MBE form submitted to procurement, there was only one MBE firm out of 2,477 labs. Therefore, the MBE goal was set at 0%. The Environmental Operations group has taken over the management of this contract.
