**Remarks:** This contract has been active since July 2021 and is an on-call

service to haul and dispose of leachate from Brown Station Road

Sanitary Landfill. It is in place to manage excess landfill leachate generation that cannot be treated by the on-site pre-treatment facility due to operational limitations or severe weather events. There are no guaranteed minimum or maximum quantities of leachate that require off-site transport and disposal for the duration of the contract. Due to the unusually high volume of leachate at the site, additional hauling and disposal is necessary. The amount of this change order adds 216,619 gallons of disposal capacity per month for the remaining 16 months of the contract, which was calculated based on average monthly hauling quantities throughout the contract period.
